



## KŐBÁNYAI SZÉCHENYI ISTVÁN KÉT TANÍTÁSI NYELVŰ ÁLTALÁNOS ISKOLA

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## INTRODUCTION

The Kőbányai Széchenyi István Bilingual Primary School is a full-time educational institution. In the school year of 2016/17 we are working together with more than 500 students and 55 educators. The students are organized in 23 classes. Half of our pupils are from the neighbouring Újhegyi housing complex. The number of boys and girls is more or less the same. The amount of underprivileged students is 145 (29%) and there are 107 (21%) children with integration, learning or behavioral problems. The main profile of our school is the elevated level of foreign language teaching which affects more than 60% of our children.



**The local pedagogical program** of our institution sets the goals for the educational work. From these goals I would like to outline the following (taking into account the particularities of the different age ranges of the students):



**Lower grades:** Besides developing the key competencies, skills and abilities, it is also important for us to help the unfolding of unique talents and abilities, the catching up of disadvantaged students, the learning of foreign languages, keeping up the interest for the environment and healthy living as well as a lot of motion games.

**Upper grades:** Besides our educational work we think it is important to set the foundation for the integration into the society. We are trying to do this by familiarizing our pupils with the civil rights and obligations, basic ethical standards and the European values, in order to prepare them for their further education. Our educational work is characterized by competency-based education, talent management and development workshops. All these are complemented by our study clubs – chess, guitar, roller-skates – like other innovations, school camps and a rich cultural program selection. The programs related to István Széchenyi, after whom the school was named – like commemorations, academic competitions, excursions, wreathing – offers year by year a more colorful and richer opportunity for our pupils.
